His Plans are greater than ours!

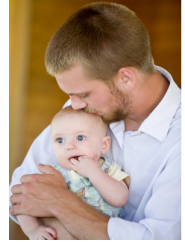

May 1st I had the opportunity to reach beyond my neighborhood and give fathers in a Louisiana prison a chance to share the Gospel with their children. Returning Heart Celebration (RHC) is a program started by AWANA® to help fathers, in prison be able to reconcile with their children and share the Gospel with them. On May 1st, 574 children came into Angola prison and spent the day with their fathers. I was able to help run some of the carnival



games and watch as these Christian fathers behind bars prayed with and witnessed to their children. What a wonderful display of God's forgiveness and love as these fathers seek to show their children the right way to live even from behind bars. It is amazing that God can use regular people like me to help men in Angola prison be able to make a difference in the lives of their children. It was truly humbling to see how excited these offenders were to be able to have the chance to spend the day with their children and share the

Gospel with them.

The question then is are we that ready and excited to share the Gospel with those around us in our neighborhood and beyond?
